Sanctification is an act of separation from that which is evil, and of dedication unto God. The Scriptures teach a life of holiness because “without holiness no one will see the Lord.” (Heb. 12:4) By the power of the Holy Spirit we are able to obey the command: “Be holy, because I am holy.” (1 Peter 1:15-16)

Sanctification is realized in the believer by recognizing his identification with Christ in His death and resurrection, and by faith reckoning daily upon the fact of that union, and by offering every faculty continually to be under the dominion of the Holy Spirit. One aspect of holiness is not doing what is evil.

Another aspect of holiness is seeing all human life as sacred and created by God in His image. We believe that God wonderfully and immutably creates each person as male or female. These two distinct, complementary genders together reflect the image and nature of God. (Gen. 1:26-27) Rejection of one's biological sex is a rejection of the image of God within that person. We believe that God has commanded that no intimate sexual activity be engaged in outside of a marriage between a man and a woman. We believe that any form of sexual immorality (including adultery, fornication, homosexual behavior, pornography, etc.) is sinful and offensive to God. (Matthew 15:18-20, 1 Cor. 6:9-10, 1 Tim. 1:9-11) (The above paragraphs are quotes taken from King's Cathedral's Statement of Faith.)

1 Thessalonians 4:3-7 “It is God's will that you should be sanctified: that you should avoid sexual immorality; that each of you should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honorable, not in passionate lust like the pagans, who do not know God; and that in this matter no one should wrong or take advantage of a brother or sister. The Lord will punish all those who commit such sins, as we told you and warned you before. For God did not call us to be impure, but to live a holy life.”

1 Timothy 4:12 “Don't let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith and in purity.”

_____ As much as it depends on me, I will do my best to “live at peace with everyone”. (Rom 12:18)

_____ Students cannot have dangerous items at school, including but not limited to guns, knives, matches,

lighters, or weapons of any kind.

_____ Cell phones must be turned off, and placed in the designated location in each classroom until the end of the school day, unless special permission is given by the teacher.

_____ I will abide by the school dress code with a good attitude.

_____ I will encourage those around me as they live for Christ.

_____ I will make a reasonable effort to do well in all subjects.

_____ I will ask for help, understanding that one purpose of the church is to encourage each other as we follow Christ.

_____ I will regularly attend church.

_____ I will do my best to pray and read my Bible every day.

_____ I will speak respectfully to and about all school staff, students, and volunteers. I will refrain from disparaging, discouraging, and profane rhetoric, which includes, but is not limited to my speech, written words, and social media.
